PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Our Cassette Blind systems are designed to suit many different applications and used primarily for room darkening, blackout and sun screens for windows, doors and skylights. Specifically designed for more intensive commercial environments such as Schools and Hospitals, Cassette Blinds feature unrivalled light exclusion properties when used in conjunction with a blackout fabric whilst also being easy to operate and virtually maintenance free.

SPECIFICATION

All hardware is powder coated and finished in Black or White. Available in three sizes (System 40, 55 & 90) our Cassette blinds can be installed to almost any window and are available up to a maximum size of 3000 wide by 3500 drop. Each blind features a fabric roller blind fitted into a one piece extruded aluminium cassette box which is neat and unobtrusive. This cassette box is connected to two part adjustable aluminium side guides which fit to each side of the window ensuring a perfect fit even when the window is not square. Securing buttons fitted directly to the blind ensures the fabric remains within the side guides. The roller blind simply raises and lowers to the desired position up and down the side guides to create the desired effect. High levels of blackout are achieved thanks to brush seals and light transfer baffles in the side channels and head box. An aluminium bottom rail is secured to the base of the roller blind to ensure maximum light exclusion and a neat finish.

Three systems are available as standard. The system 40 is ideal for smaller windows and door panels and has a cassette box measuring just 420 x 420mm. System 55 is suitable for most applications and has a cassette box measuring 550 x 550mm while the System 90, which is suitable for the largest windows, has a cassette box measuring 890 x 890mm.

CONTROL OPTIONS

Cassette blinds come with a variety of control options. System 40 and System 55 blinds are available with chain operation allowing the user to operate the blind by way of a hard wearing plastic control chain. Also available on both these systems is a spring operation which features a premium quality spring decelerator mechanism which smoothly rolls the blind up once released. Crank or Gear operation is available on System 55 and System 90 blinds and features a heavy duty gear mechanism fitted inside the cassette box which is controlled via a detachable crank handle. Also available for System 90 blinds is electric motor operation with remote control.

INSTALLATION

Cassette blinds can be installed to almost any window and location. The cassette box is mounted with either steel top fix or aluminium face fix brackets. The side guides are fitted either face fix directly to the window or side fix to the recess sides.

FABRICS

Cassette blinds are available with a wide range of flame retardant fabrics and include fabrics that are blackout, dim-out, solar reflective or wipe clean. An extensive range of colours is available to suit any specification or requirement.
